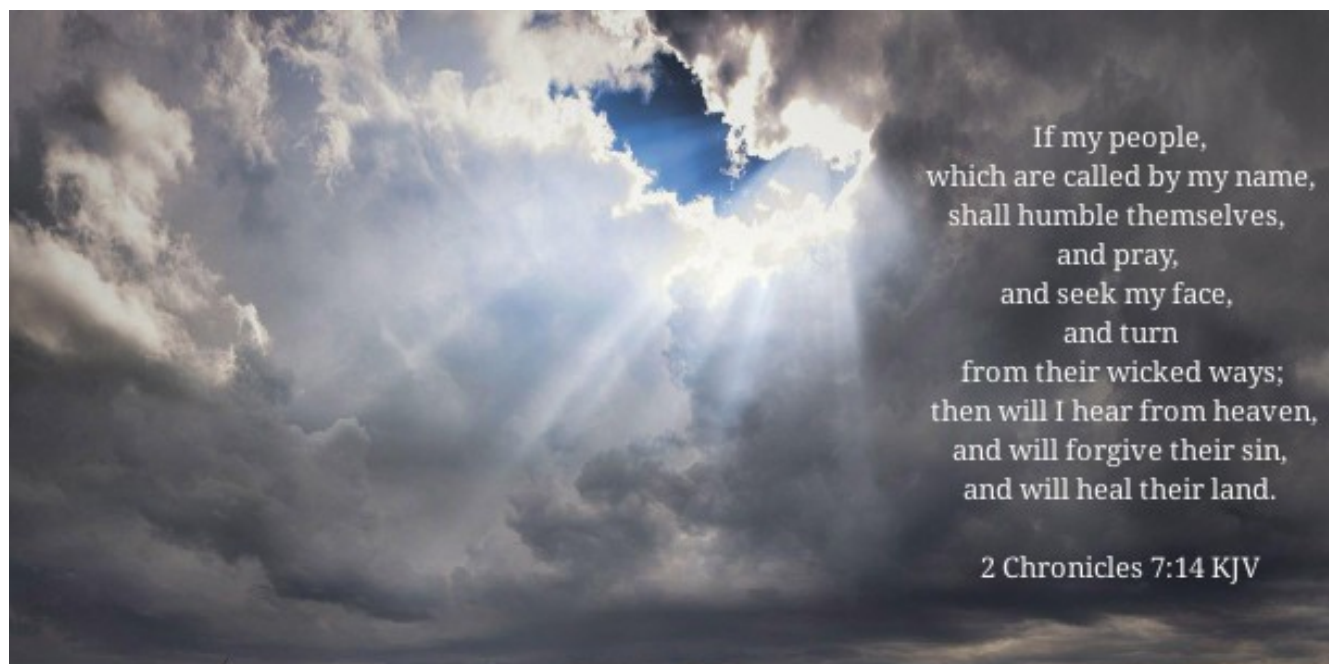


## *Seward United Methodist Church News Stream January 10th*
